Teachers were invited to the elementary environment to watch Pragyan narrating a special write-up on martial arts, one of the oldest form of defence.

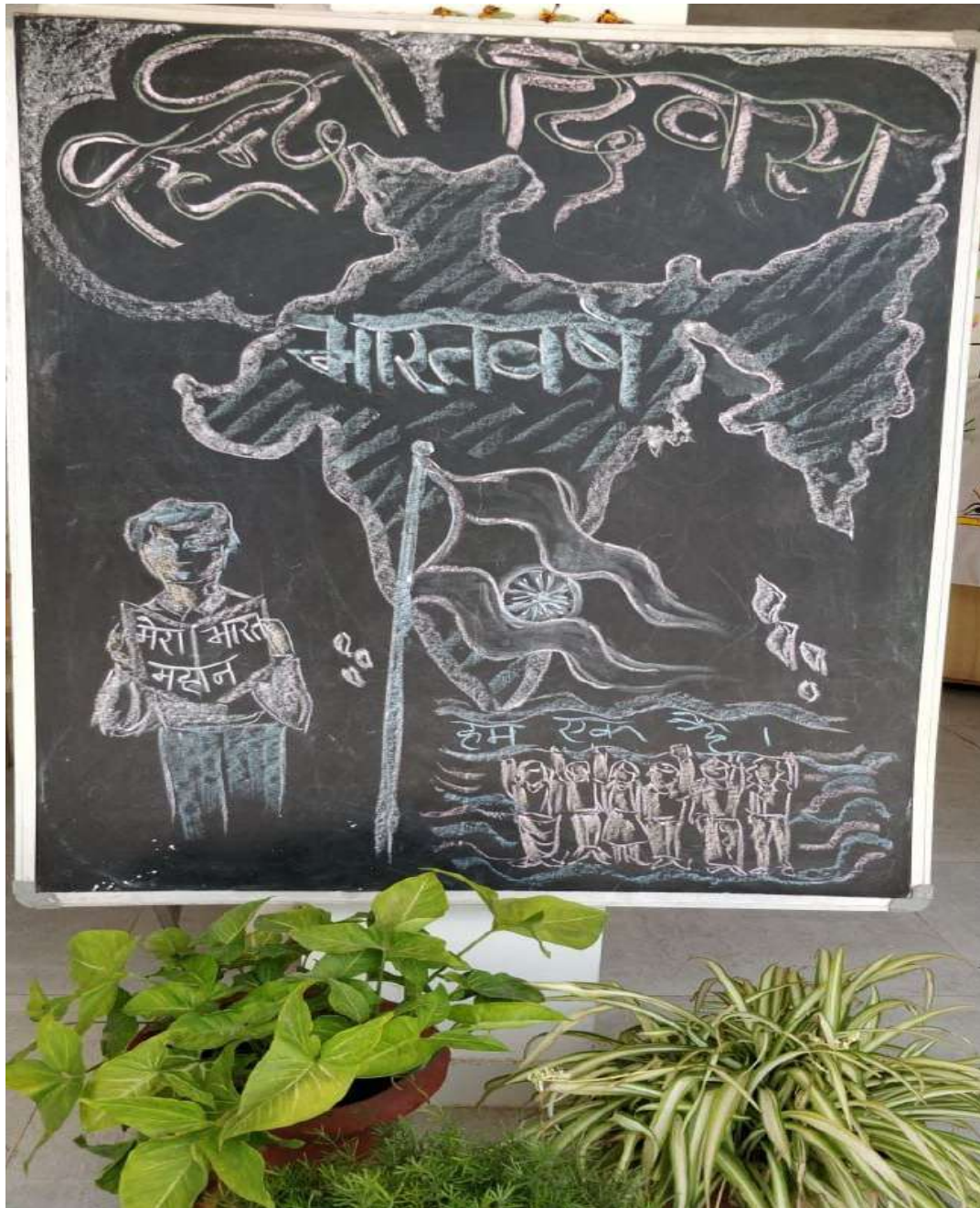
Aruthra captivated the attention of all the children as well as the teachers in the environment through her newly inculcated art of story- telling.
